How to Prepare Your Talk

1. Choose Your Topic

Pick **one topic** and think about the most interesting ideas you want to share.

2. Organise Your Talk

• Introduction (1–2 minutes):

Say your name, introduce your topic, and explain why you chose it.

• Main Part (5–6 minutes):

Talk about 2–3 main points. Give examples, details, or comparisons.

Example: family traditions in Algeria vs. another country / different types of transport and their problems / why students feel stressed during exams and how to manage it.

Conclusion (2–3 minutes)

- Use short but complete sentences.
- Try to use **linking words**: first, next, finally, in my opinion, for example, on the other hand.
- Speak slowly, clearly, and confidently.
